The City of Monterey Parking Division invites Old Town residents to attend this neighborhood meeting to review the current Residential Parking Permit (RPP) requalification results and understand what they mean for your block. At this time, the neighborhood has not met the participation requirements needed to continue in the updated voluntary program. If requalification thresholds are not reached before existing permits expire on April 30, 2026, on-street permit parking restrictions will be removed and the area will not be eligible to reapply for at least three years. This meeting is an opportunity to ask questions, review next steps, and ensure residents have the information needed to make an informed decision about the future of parking on their street.
